Role

- Responding to foster queries regarding cat/kitten behaviour and health concerns via the fosterer Facebook page.
- Welcome new fosterers to the group and provide important start-up information (template provided).
- Check in with newbie fosterers to see how they're getting on.
- Support all fosterers new and old, offer guidance and advice.
- Provide support to fosterers who may have had a foster kitty pass away due to severe health issues.
- Follow up with fosterers on medical treatments and health issues.
- Reminding fosterers to fill in VTRs, and Vet appointment tabs.
